
Declaration of RoHS Compliance

The EU Directive 2011/65/EU, which refers to "Restriction of Hazardous Substances" or "RoHS", is made by the European Union (EU) and took effect on 1 July 2011. This restricts the use of the following six hazardous substances in the manufactures of various types of the electrical and electronic devices:

- Lead (Pb) < 1000 ppm
- Mercury (Hg) < 1000 ppm
- Cadmium (Cd) < 100 ppm
- Hexavalent Chromium (Cr+6) < 1000 ppm
- PolyBrominated Biphenyl (PBB) < 1000 ppm
- PolyBrominated Diphenyl Ether (PBDEs)(including Deca-BDE) < 1000 ppm
